



Manitoba Council Provincial Award

Red River Cart Award

Purpose: To recognize exemplary ongoing services to Guiding in the Province of Manitoba. Presentation to be made at the Provincial Annual Meeting. One or more may be presented in each year.

Guidelines:

1. The nominee must hold a current appointment
2. The nominee must hold the Medal of Merit or higher
3. Her service to whatever position(s) the nominee holds must be above and beyond the requirements of the position(s) held
4. Her service need not be known province-wide
5. The nominee must intend to continue serving Guiding in an appointed position
6. Each application will be considered carefully on its merits by the Awards Committee and ratified by the Council or Executive
7. This award is not intended to recognize service given for any one specific Guiding event. Services can be in relation to adults or girls
8. Applications and a minimum of three letters must be sent to the Awards Chairwoman.

The Red River Cart Award will be a presentation pin and a ribbon. The presentation pin can be worn in or out of uniform.

Red River Cart Award Plaque – A recipient of this award will have her name and year of presentation engraved on a perpetual plaque located in the Manitoba Council Office.
