PEI Members

- STANDARD – \$65 PER
- EMERGENCY – \$47.50 PER
- *MENTAL HEALTH – \$75 PER
- *STANDARD / HCP – \$70 PER

NB Members

- STANDARD – \$120.00 PER
- EMERGENCY - \$90.00 PER
- *MENTAL HEALTH – \$145.00PER
- *STANDARD / HCP – \$130.00 PER

* PRE-REQUISITES

- MENTAL HEALTH – NO CERTIFICATE NEEDED BUT MUST BE 18 YEARS OF AGE
- HCP – NO CERTIFICATE NEEDED BUT MUST BE A HEALTH CARE PROVIDER

Should it be necessary to cancel or reschedule, please note the following:

- **Cancellations with 6+ business days' notice will receive a FULL refund OR may choose to transfer to an alternate date with no transfer fee.**
- **Cancellations with 3-5 business days' notice will be charged a \$40 (plus tax) administration fee OR may choose to transfer to an alternate date (see below regarding transfers)**
- **Cancellations within 1-2 business days' notice may choose to transfer to an alternate date(see below regarding transfers); however, a refund is NOT available**
- **NO Shows will NOT receive a refund or credit**

****There will be a transfer fee of \$25 (plus tax) for transfers requested with 5 business days' notice, or less, prior to the class date**

GROUP BOOKINGS

- Courses must be booked 3 weeks in advance
- All attendees must be a registered member of Girl Guides (non-member are unable to attend)
- Course minimum 10, maximum 15

1. Choose a date (Group classes typically run 9 – 5pm)
2. Arrange your location keeping in mind the space for everyone to move around on the floor. (TV –DVD will be required for the event)
3. Arrange list of active members who would like to attend.

5. The cost of the course will be invoiced to the Area/District/and Unit- split 3 ways. Any members without a Unit will be charged at District Level.
