

# GIRL GUIDES OF CANADA – BRITISH COLUMBIA COUNCIL PROVINCIAL CAMPING COMMITTEE

## TERMS OF REFERENCE

(To be used in conjunction with the Committees' Generic Terms of Reference)

#### **PURPOSE**

To stimulate and promote an active interest and participation in camping throughout the province.

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

Membership to include: Provincial Camping Adviser *(maximum of 3 years)* Committee members

Committee members' duties may encompass the following, as assigned by the Chair:

Activity coordination
Adventure camp and Trex coordination
Committee resource coordination
Communications coordination
Training coordination
Residential and tenting coordination

### **RESPONSIBILITIES**

In addition to the generic Terms of Reference, the Provincial Camping Committee shall:

- 1. Prepare and submit to the Provincial Council for approval:
  - a) Plans and estimated costs for proposed special events
  - b) Plans to invite participants from out of province to BC events
- 2. Organize and conduct provincial camping events for girls and adults, with the approval of, or at the request of the Provincial Council.
- 3. Promote and assist with out-of-province camping events and inter-provincial events in BC with the approval of Provincial Council.
- 4. Assist groups planning to travel within Canada, by providing information and contacts as required.
- 5. Maintain contact with, and support the work of Area Camping Advisers and those at the district-level who are involved with camping (where applicable) by:
  - a) providing conferences, workshops, courses, publications and camping experiences
  - b) keeping the Camping Advisers' Handbook current
  - c) circulating camping publications as required
  - d) promoting the use of the *Outdoor Activity Leadership* modules of the *Training Enrichment for Adult Members (TEAM).*
  - e) promoting opportunities for camp training for Guiders
- 6. Care, maintain, use, replace and update any camping related provincially-owned equipment as required.
