

## **Core Crew Travel Baseline Rates – January 20, 2016**

As indicated in the Core Crew Travel Directive, para 2. (e):

On January 20, the Travel Agent that has been assigned for GM2016 Core Crew Travel will get prices for flights to/from Calgary and Edmonton airports from/to all major airports across Canada to be used as a baseline rate for cost of travel. These rates will be used to determine the travel amounts that will be covered for Core Crew that decide to make alternate travel arrangements or deviations for personal travel purposes. These will apply for travel by air, rail, or by road.

NOTE: All rates are based on Canadian dollars (\$CAD) and include taxes
