

GUEST 2020 on Vancouver Island GUides Exploring Science and Technology Information Sheet



GUEST 2020 on the Island is an opportunity for Guides to have fun while exploring science and technology. Girls will visit the University of Victoria campus in Victoria, sleep in the university dormitories, and join in hands-on science activities led by local scientists and engineers.

Date & Time	Check-in: 11:30 AM. – 12:00 PM, Saturday, May 30, 2020 Depart: 12:00 PM, Sunday, May 31, 2020
Participants	Patrols of one Guider and four Guides (plus one alternate Guide) from Districts in <u>Pacific Shores and Southern Vancouver Island Areas.</u>
Cost	\$420 per Patrol (\$400 + \$20 tax). Includes all activities, Saturday accommodations in the university dorms, Saturday dinner, Sunday breakfast, and snacks throughout the event. Note: Lunches <i>will not</i> be provided or reimbursed. Lunch cost is the patrol's responsibility.
Travel	Patrols must arrange their own travel to and from the event. Patrols will be reimbursed for up to 1 vehicle traveling from their own community; parking will be provided for up to 1 vehicle per patrol. All travel at the event will be by chartered bus.
You must provide your own lunch on both event days. On Saturday, please eat before arriving at the event. For Sunday, bring food or buy lunch after leaving the event. Refrigerators will be available at the residence to keep labeled food in.

Applications will be accepted between February 10, 2020 and March 6 2020. Space is limited to 24 patrols (120 participants, including Guiders) and will be filled by lottery if more applications are received.

Patrols will be contacted by email (*see below) by approximately March 31, 2020 to advise if your patrol has been selected. Upon being selected you will receive a patrol registration package. Patrols that have <i>not</i> been selected will be waitlisted until April 17, 2020. If your patrol has not been selected for the event by this date, we will destroy your cheque for the patrol fee.	
Refunds and Changes to Patrols:	

- We will destroy your cheque for your patrol fee if your patrol withdraws from the event on or before March 31, 2020. We cannot refund patrol fees for patrols that withdraw after March 31, 2020.
- Each accepted patrol may designate an alternate girl; if a participant withdraws from your patrol your designated alternate may take her place, provided that we receive notice of the change on or before May 1, 2020. We cannot accommodate changes to patrols after May 1, 2020.
- We cannot partially refund patrol fees if a participant withdraws and is not replaced.

Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted, the cheque must still be in the office by March 6, 2020. Send your payment to:
