University of Victoria, Victoria, BC May 30 - May 31, 2020

Register as a patrol (4 girls plus 1 Guider). Registration is limited to 24 patrols (120 participants, including Guiders).

Who: Open to Guide patrols from the Pacific Shores and Southern Vancouver Island Areas

When: Check-in: 11:30 AM – 12:00 PM, Saturday, May 30, 2020

Depart: 12:00 PM, Sunday, May 31, 2020

Cost: \$420 per patrol (this works out to \$105 per girl)

This includes the rental cost for the facilities, accommodations, all activities, dinner Saturday night, breakfast Sunday morning, snacks and the cost of travel (reimbursed to the patrol Guiders as per the application form)... AND the very cool event crest shown on this page!

Note: the ACTUAL cost for this event is well over \$200 per girl; BC Council is subsidizing more than \$100 per girl, or the profits from 10 cases of cookies sold for each girl.
