Letter of Recommendation (0 points)

In order to submit your application, you will need to provide a **letter of recommendation from within Guiding**. Your recommender must have reached the age of majority in your province, not be a member of your family, and provide their membership (iMIS) number.

Note: If you are <u>unable</u> to submit a recommender from *within* Guiding, you may use an external recommender. If you *do* provide an external recommender, you will have an opportunity to explain why in the Personal Information section of your application. No extra points will be awarded for references within Guiding.

Please find the recommender form <u>on our website</u>. It is your responsibility to email your recommender with the form as well as what the opportunity entails (we suggest you include the position description, for their reference).

Your recommender will be asked to explain why they believe you should be chosen to participate in this camp. They'll be prompted to speak to your character, suitability for this camp, and ability to work well in a team setting (particularly with youth). They'll have up to 400 words to provide their letter of recommendation. Be sure to select a recommender who knows you well and who can provide enough detail and background to properly comment on these aspects.

Important: Your recommender should send the completed form directly to Girl Guides of Canada at events@girlguides.ca. Once received, you will receive a confirmation email from GGC.

It is YOUR responsibility to make sure the recommendation is submitted by the recommendation deadline – Monday, February 11, 2019 at 4 p.m. ET. Applicants with an outstanding recommendation will not have the ability to submit their application.
