Who's eligible?

- 20 girls aged 14-15 years old on the first day of the trip
- 4 Guiders

To qualify for a Nationally Sponsored Trip, you must be a registered member of Girl Guides of Canada–Guides du Canada (GGC) and meet the Eligibility Requirements.

For Girls, keep in mind that in order to be eligible for this travel experience, you must be registered as a girl member at the time of the trip, fall 2018.

Additionally, for this trip Girls must have a minimum of two nights camping experience at the Guide level or higher and Guiders must have a minimum of two nights camping experience as an adult member.

What you'll experience

Join girls from across the country on a trip to Sydney where Girl Guides Australia is hosting an incredible camping event!

You'll begin your journey in Vancouver, where you'll participate in some great activities to get to know your fellow travellers. Then it's off to Australia where your international adventure truly begins.

In Australia, you'll enjoy several days of sightseeing and exploration. Your travel group will preplan your adventures, so it's entirely up to the group to decide what to see and do. Then you'll head to Sydney Olympic Park for a week of camping, friendship and fun at [Jamboree!](#)

At camp, you'll participate in a wide range of activities including canoeing, hiking, outdoor cooking, crafts, swimming, and games. You'll experience activities that range from the time-honoured and traditional to the innovative and hi-tech, with so much in between. At night you'll camp in the great outdoors by the Parramatta River, close to wetlands and a vast array of bird life. You'll also get to experience an overnight expedition in which you'll choose from a variety of adventure opportunities such as canyoning, horseback riding and more!

At the end of your journey, you'll fly back to Vancouver for a debrief session where you'll reflect on your amazing experience before returning home.





Fundraising facts

The total value of this program is approximately **\$6,530** per person.

Girls: Great news - GGC covers 50% of the total cost of the trip!

- You will receive a financial subsidy of 50% of the total cost from GGC including domestic and international airfare, accommodation, booking and program fees, tours and transfers, and medical and travel insurance.
- You are encouraged to fundraise for the remainder of your trip costs. Refer to GGC's Fundraising Guidelines for information on how to fundraise for trips. As per the fundraising policy, all Girl members are expected to pay 10% of the trip cost unless there is financial need.
- You may be eligible for travel grants from your province, area, unit, etc. It is recommended that you contact your council to inquire about this potential funding.
- You will be financially responsible to pay for the remaining 50% of the trip cost prior to trip departure.
- You will also be responsible for incidental costs over and above the listed trip expenses, such as passport fees, travel to and from your local airport, personal spending money, etc. Incidental costs cannot be covered through fundraising.
- If you need to cancel for any reason other than illness or a family emergency, you will be responsible for covering any fees/charges incurred by GGC.

Guiders: Your trip is fully funded through the Jean Youngson Memorial Bequest to the Canadian World Friendship Fund.

- This subsidy includes domestic and international airfare, accommodation, booking and program fees, tours and transfers and medical and travel insurance.
- You will be responsible for incidental costs over and above the listed trip expenses, such as passport fees, travel to and from your local airport, personal spending money, etc.
- Fundraising by adult members is not permitted as per GGC's fundraising policy.

GGC reserves the right to cancel and/or reschedule trips as required. Also note that participation in this event by GGC members is dependent on acceptable health and safety conditions in the country at the time of the event. If a trip is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, GGC will not accept responsibility for expenses incurred in preparation for this event.
