PURPOSE

To advise and support the Program team on strategies, communications and issues related to the development, implementation, and delivery of GGC girl member programs. We are looking to recruit one youth member (under the age 14-17).

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collaborate with the Program team on the development, revision, delivery and implementation of current and proposed programming for girl members, including the girl program, National Service Projects, travel and events, camping and outdoors, and international programming.
- Compile and analyze feedback from stakeholders on matters related to programming and provide advice and recommendations to the Program team in support of successful programming initiatives.
- Keep informed of current issues, trends and concerns in the areas of youth programming and related activities.
- Receive, acknowledge, screen and evaluate program ideas originating from the membership, for referral to the Program team.
- Undertake other work related to programming as requested by the Program team.

REQUIREMENTS FOR POSITION

This role is especially suited to individuals who are looking to have an enduring impact on an important organization in Canadian society. We particularly invite individuals who are young women and members of Canada's diverse communities.

Successful candidates will have the following qualifications:

- Commitment to the mission and vision of Girl Guides of Canada-Guides du Canada
- Experience with and knowledge of GGC programs
- Experience in the specific areas of program development, camping, travel, international programs, or community service are considered an asset.
- For adult members, held a Unit Guider position within the last five years

TERM

This a one-year term for youth members, beginning in September 2024. The committee conducts its business via email, and meetings are held via video conference monthly during the Guiding year. The time required to serve on this committee varies from approximately five to 10 hours per month.
