Membership Matters

Did you know NS remains the 4th largest membership province, quite the feat for a small province. But we can't rest on our laurels, our membership numbers are slowly dropping, so 2019 will focus on more of the issues we are facing and how we can make sure every girl and woman wants to join us - can! One initiative is the "Try Now, Join Later" program that NS has been offering. This program runs April through August and allow girls to join for free, try out a few meetings or special events (like camps!) and put them in the cue for Phase II registration for the fall. This program has been very successful in our province as well as other's. Data reflects a 70% retention rate for the girls that have utilized the program. Just think – a small adjustment, to accommodate these girls in April, could have a big impact and WOW the girl!

And speaking of 2019.....

GGC is launching an exciting new initiative in mid-July 2019: a mini "**How to Adult**" camp based on skill-building, self-care and wellness for 2nd and 3rd year Rangers, to help them develop the tools they need to feel prepared to transition into the next stage in their lives.
