Pre-Camp:

To communicate with First Aid Coordinator.

Camp:

- To adhere to ALL the health and safety guidelines as outlined in Safe Guide.
- To be ready to report to duty no later than 5:00pm Friday.
- To maintain the First Aid station when scheduled.
- To record ALL medications and treatments given from 10 am to 10pm Saturday on appropriate Safe Guide forms.
- To attend meetings if required.
- To ensure that the First Aid area is clean.
- To report depletion of supplies within the first aid kit to the First Aid Coordinator.
- To assist with setting up first aid stations.
- To assist with closing of the first aid station.
- To ensure the First Aid Binder is secure at all times while on duty.
- To assist with traffic control / security during Friday night arrival and Sunday morning departure, if needed

Post-Camp:

To assist with closing of the campsite.
