# **Cancellation Policy for Private Groups:**

- >Classes which are cancelled more than 15 business days prior to the scheduled start date, will be subject to a \$40 (+ Tax) administration fee.
- >Cancellations within 15 business days of the scheduled start date, will be charged 50% of the cost of training (based on the minimum number of students required and any additional fees incurred (ie, travel, accommodations, etc

## **Cancellation Policy for Individual:**

- > All registration fees are 100% non-refundable
- > Cancellations received with 6 or more business days' notice, prior to the class start date, are permitted to transfer to a new date with no fee.
- > Cancellations received within 3-5 business days prior to the class start date are permitted to reschedule to a new date with a transfer fee of \$25 plus tax.
- > Cancellations received 1-2 business days prior to the class start date are non-transferable.
- > No-shows are non- transferable





## **GROUP BOOKINGS**

- Courses must be booked 3 weeks in advance
- All attendees must be a registered member of Girl Guides (non-member are unable to attend)
- Course minimum 10, maximum 15
  - 1. Choose a date (Group classes typically run 9 5pm)
  - 2. Arrange your location keeping in mind the space for everyone to move around on the floor. (TV –DVD will be required for the event)
  - 3. Arrange list of active members who would like to attend.
  - 4. Send you completed Private Course Registration Form to <a href="mailto:ns-excutiveassistant@girlguides.ca">ns-excutiveassistant@girlguides.ca</a> including names, birthdates, IMIS #s, and Unified Banking Ids'
  - 5. The cost of the course will be invoiced to the Area/District/and Unit-split 3 ways. Any members without a Unit will be charged at District Level.
