Responsibilities:

Pre-Camp

- To attend the Adventure pre-camp planning meetings face to face or via video conference call.
- To Chair the pre-camp planning meetings for your out trip and to be financially responsible for the budgeted amount allocated to the Canoeing Adventure Program
- To review all guidelines as outlined in Safe Guide in conjunction with the Adventure Camp Team Lead
- To ensure that all Guiders and participants have the necessary qualifications to attend a canoeing backcountry trip
- To work with the other Guiders leading backcountry expeditions to ensure the efficient planning and delivery of the canoeing Adventure Activity.
- To select campsites for the canoeing activity
- To purchase/borrow and organize all supplies for the canoeing Adventure Activity.
- Work with the Food Services Team Lead to arrange for food

Camp

- To attend staff meetings when at Jeremy's Bay
- To set up and organize the Canoeing Adventure Activity.
- To advise the Adventure Team Lead of any changes

Post Camp

- To assist with closing of the campsite
- To prepare a final Canoeing Adventure Activity Report of the camp and forward it to the Adventure Camp Team Lead
- To return all external resource equipment, supplies and resources to the Adventure Camp Team Lead
