

Cookie Committee Role and Responsibilities

ROLE

- To support Girl Guides of Canada, Ontario Council to continue to improve and increase cookie sales
- To support and encourage volunteers in Ontario Council for successful cookie campaigns
- To carry out any additional work as directed by the Provincial Council
- To consult with other committees in order to combine the expertise of all for the benefit of Guiding in Ontario and Nunavut

MEMBERS

Membership shall include:

- Provincial Cookie Liaison (Chair)
- Members at large (2-5)
- Youth Member at large (2)

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Provincial Cookie Committee shall:

- Develop and recommend proposals appropriate to create new cookie selling opportunities for units in Ontario Council
- 2. Provide advice to Administrative Community Leaders (ACLs) on how to best support units with cookie selling activities or concerns
- 3. Work directly with ACLs to source and recruit Cookie Receivers in locations where they are required
- 4. Provide feedback based on trends about the annual Ontario Council cookie orders and present it, via the Provincial Treasurer, to Ontario Council
- Consider all questions of a cookie nature which may be referred to by the Provincial Commissioner, Ontario Council, and other committees, and submit recommendations based on Ontario Council financial standards
- 6. Report on activities and provide recommendations, via the Chair, to Council in the Treasurer's usual tabled report
