The Quebec Provincial Youth Council is excited to present the Quebec Superguides Challenge! The council hopes that by participating in this challenge girls will feel empowered. Following this short introduction, you can find the activities each level has to complete to receive the badge and pin. A description of each activity is under the title. Please make sure you read through the additional

criteria to ensure that your group is eligible to receive the badge and pin. The challenge will be open from November 20, 2020 to January 31, 2021. We will try to mail your groups stuff by February 20th but due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, there may be delays. This challenge is only open to members of Girl Guides Quebec.

Additional Criteria

- 1. Share at least one photo with us by emailing **qc-youth@guidescanada.ca**. As well, include your unit name, the number of girls who completed the challenge and an address that the badges can be sent to.
- Please ensure that if a girl's face is visible, she has her photorelease. As well, their last names should not be present. These photos will be posted on the Youth Councils instagram (@guidesqc.pyc.cjp).

Sparks

- Make a card

Design and create your own card with a kind message. Send or deliver your card to a friend, a girl you know who has not returned to guiding, a family member, teacher or whoever you'd like. Try to give your card to someone who has been working hard during the pandemic or to someone who is going through a difficult time. Whoever you choose to give the card to, we are sure it will brighten their day!

- The Superguide exercise

Read the story resource out loud to your sparks. While going through the story, do the accompanying exercises and encourage your girls to do them as well. The story ressource can be found below in the resource section.

- Become a superhero

Using household items, come to your meeting dressed like a superhero. Share what you used and how you used them with the rest of your group. For example, use a blanket as a cape.

- The superhero song

Sing the "I Am A Superhero" song found in the resource section below.

Tip from the Youth Council: Having all girls sing the song at once on virtual platforms may be difficult. Have your girls mute their microphones and sing along in their homes. That way, there will be no interference with the girls hearing you call out the leaders part of the song.



Brownies

- Make a card

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- What's your superpower?

Ask girls to share what their one word superpower is. Take notes of the words they say and make them into a word cloud. Send your word cloud to <u>qc-youth@guidescanada.ca</u> for it to be potentially made into a virtual badge! Examples of superpowers are: reading, drawing, being kind, tidy, etc...

Tip #1 from the Youth Council: If you don't have a preferred word cloud generator, try wordclouds.com . There are lots of different tools you can play around with!

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Guides

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- What's your empowering word?

Ask girls to share what their empowering word is (try to keep it to one word). Take notes of the words they say and make them into a word cloud. Send your word cloud to <u>qc-</u> <u>youth@guidescanada.ca</u> for it to be potentially made into a virtual badge! Examples of empowering words are: Worthy, Passionate, Purposeful, creative, Kind, etc....

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- Who's your superhero?

Ask each girl to choose a female superhero in their life. After a minute of reflection, ask each girl to share their superhero and why.

- Empowering collage

Using the face outline resource, cut out words from magazines and newspapers that apply to the creator. Each girl should have the same face outline if possible. If girls do not have newspapers or magazines, they can write their own words and use them. Photos can be used as well.



Pathfinders

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- I AM A GIRL pledge

Make your own I Am A Girl pledge. As a group or individually, write your own pledge with the first line being I AM A GIRL. If you choose to separate the lines, give each girl one or two lines to write. Once everyone is done, put them together and read them aloud. Two I Am A Girl pledges are included in the resource section below as inspiration.

The Last Battle; A Battle Against Incredible Girl and Frightening Flower
