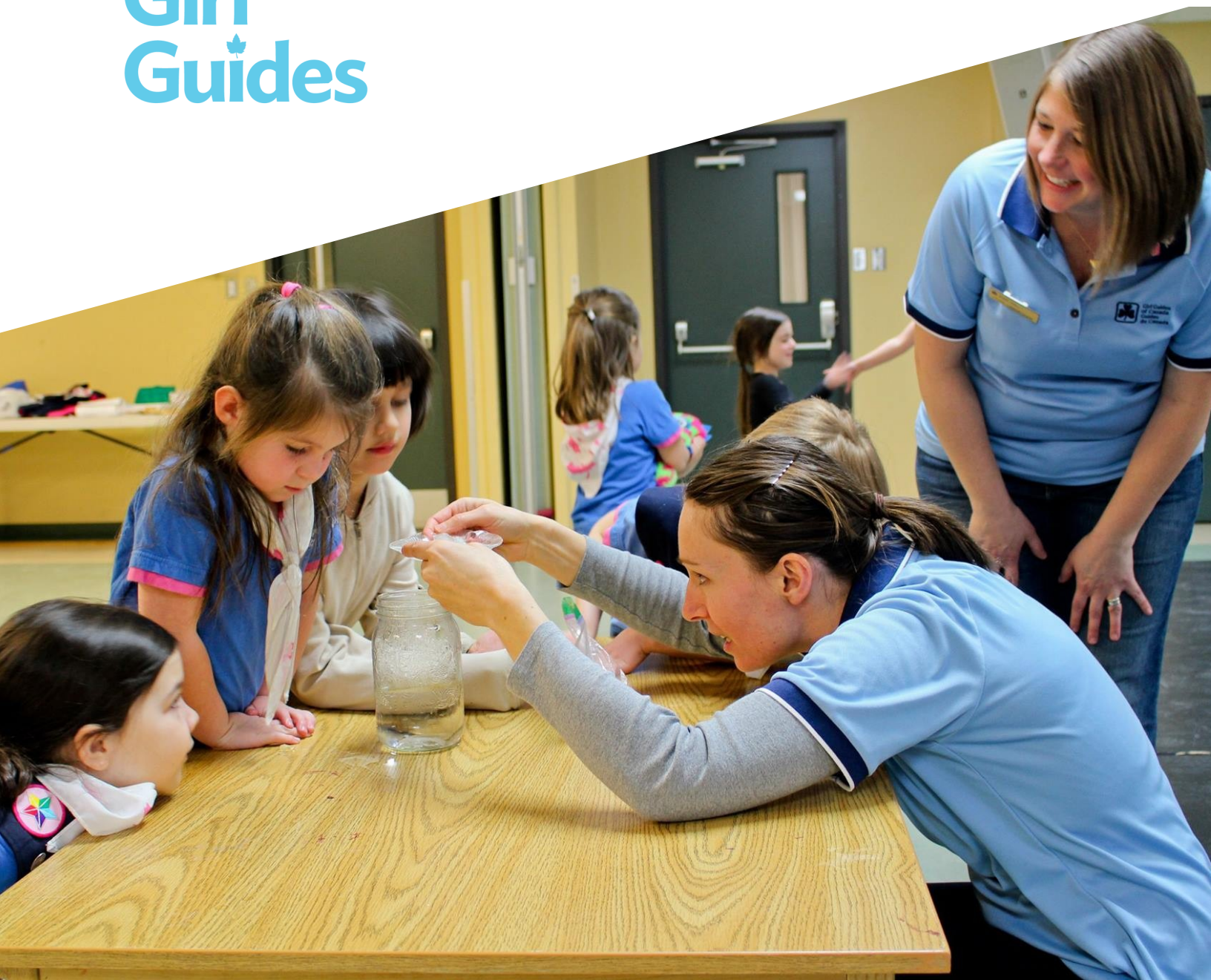


So you're thinking about volunteering with Girl Guides...
