1920s

- 1920, Provincial Council formed with small office and supply depot in Victoria
- 1921, BC Guides inspected by Edward, Prince of Wales
- 1923, BC Guiding started to form Divisions and Districts
- Land and Sea Rangers were formed
- 1923, Lord and Lady Baden Powell made their first visit to Canada
- Brownies were organized and presented with their Registration Certificate from Lady BP. Local Associations were also formed the same year
- 1924, the First Lones Company founded by Phyllis Munday, who soon became the first National Lones Adviser. Since then, BC Lones have been found in Canadian Embassies abroad, as well as BC Forestry camps, lighthouses and remote locations. Girls were recruited with help from the BC Correspondence School
- 1925, a Provincial office was opened in a small room in Victoria
- 1927, a National Camp was held in Victoria called All Canada Jubilee Camp, led by Miss Mara, Commandant at University School in Victoria
