DAWN - Newfoundland and Labrador - Interprovincial Camp 2019 July 27- Aug 8, 2019

Information Sheet - Participant Application details

What

Participants will meet in Vancouver area, and travel to Newfoundland to participate in the DAWN (Discovery! Adventure! Wonder! Nature!) Interprovincial Camp planned by the Newfoundland & Labrador Provincial Council, hosted in the Gros Morne National park. Similar to SOAR, the camp will be a true basic camping experience involving an amazing program full of challenge and fun including adventures in water activities, arts, crafts, and sports. We will then spend 3 days to explore and experience Newfoundland before traveling home.

Where

Gros Morne National Park & travel touring around Newfoundland

When

July 27- Aug 8, 2019

Who

Sixteen (16) girls born between 2001 and 2003 + two (4) alternates Two (2) plus two (2) Alternate Guiders

Cost

The total value of this program is approximately \$3700 per person. Girls will receive a subsidy of \$3100, making the invoice cost to the girl \$600. This fee includes the DAWN camp fee, accommodations in Newfoundland and Vancouver, meals in Newfoundland and Vancouver, all flights, local travel, and sightseeing fees in Newfoundland. BC Council travel policy for girls and Guiders attending Provincial events will apply for participants' travel to and from Vancouver

Not included in the event fee

- Travel medical insurance
- Kit list and uniform requirements
- Spending money for souvenirs

If you need additional financial support, please check with your Area Camping Adviser to see if your Area and or District Councils may be able to assist you with this event. Girl members may fundraise part of their trip cost by following the fundraising policy and procedures (Governance Policy 01-19-01).

Qualifications

- Six consecutive or non-consecutive nights at Girl Guide camps in tents (minimum of 2 nights in a
- Ability to adapt and work co-operatively.
- Ability to cope with daily camp and travel activities.
- Completed swim or boat test record in iMIS by March 1, 2019.
- Guiders must have Standard First Aid certification valid during travel and entered in iMIS by March 1, 2019.

It is your responsibility to tell your references the details of the camp(s) you are applying for and to give them plenty of time to meet your deadline.

If you are applying for more than one camp, one application is sufficient, but you must answer all the questions keeping in mind the different types you are applying for.

Incomplete, late, or faxed applications will not be accepted.

Submit your application online no later than November 1st, 2018

*You will be notified via email about whether you have been selected by late December 2018.
