RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Connecting with your two groups in advance of the event by email: Introduce yourself, welcome the group, create a team name
- Coordinating H.1 forms (and H.3 if needed) in advance (and ensure these are with you onsite)
- Collecting and welcoming group upon arrival
- Ensuring group members who have not granted image release on their IR.1 are wearing yellow bands
- Staying with your groups and acting as an adult ally for them throughout the day (ensure girls with dietary restrictions get the right meal, washroom breaks, flow of events)
- o Ensuring girls are having a good time and getting engaged
- Ensure group members sign out before leaving

- o Great communication skills and desire to help make girls feel comfortable
- o Organized, reliable and good at solving problems
- Possess positive energy and a passion for Guiding and the new Girls First program!
