## **Chromatography Butterfly**


## What you need:

- Felt markers, in several colours
- Coffee filter
- Shallow dish of water
- Scissors

## What to do:

Draw a picture of a butterfly on the coffee filter.


Use the seam of the filter for the butterfly's body and extend the wings onto the filter.



Cut out the butterfly shape.

Colour the body of your butterfly with several colours of felt marker. The
body will turn black or very dark brown. Leave the wings white.





## How it works:

The black colour of the body is really made up of lots of other colours. The ink is drawn along tiny tubes within the paper in a process called *capillary action*. Heavier colours don't move as far as lighter ones, so the colours spread out gradually as the water moves further out into the wings of your butterfly.
